

The Liturgy Box

Welcome! *Directions to make the most of your Liturgy Box:*

1. START HERE: Peel off back of this page and apply to the inside of the box lid. **This Calendar** is a handy guide for Lent, and **these Directions** explain how to use the box contents.

2. Prayer Guides: **Purple** is for Lent. **Ivory**, Holy Week.

3. Practicing Confession: On Fridays, use Lent Prayer Guide (p. 5) for the adult **Confess to a Friend** practice and use the QR code (p. 6) for the family **Cross Confession** activity.

4. Wristbands: **Purple** is for Lent—start wearing on Ash Wednesday. **White** is for Holy Week—start wearing on Palm Sunday. They are reminders of our Memory Verses.

5. Weekly Candles and Holder: A **black candle** for days of solemn reflection, **five purple candles** for the suffering of Christ our King, an **ivory candle** for Holy Week, and a **white candle** for the holiness of our risen Savior who makes us holy.

7. FaithHeroCard: The **FaithHeroCard** highlights Thomas Cranmer (Mar 21), whose life and ministry is an example of Christian faith.

8. "Little Fast" Rice Bag: On Fridays in Lent try the spiritual practice of fasting. The **bag of rice** reminds us to have a **simple family meal of rice and water on Fridays**.

9. Recipes: Try baking the Palm Sunday cake (advanced) and the Easter Resurrection Rolls (beginner). Recipes are provided in the Prayer Guides.

10. "Little Feast" Candy Bags: Sundays in Lent are little Easter feasts, anticipating the great feast on Easter day. Enjoy one **pink or purple sweet** each Sunday. But save the **golden Reese's cup** for Easter!
